#### From the Desk of Pastor Keith

Happy new year! The days of 2016 have come and gone. We stand now at the beginning of a brand new year. We dare to enter this new year with great hope because we know that God will be with us. (How fortunate it is that the beginning of a new year so closely follows Christmas when we celebrate the birth of Jesus. In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus is called Emmanuel, which means "God is with us.")

I want to thank each and every one of you for your partnership in Christ's mission throughout 2016. Week after week and month after month I have observed you sharing your gifts and ministering to others in the name of Jesus. The Spirit of Christ is at work in and through you! For your faithful ministry I thank you.

Carol and I also want to thank you for the cards and gifts and expressions of Christmas joy and hope during the Christmas season. What a joy it is to be part of these two great congregations!

It has now been two years since I began serving as your interim pastor. The time has gone by quickly. It is truly a wonderful privilege to serve with you and I look forward to our continued partnership in the months to come.

Some of you have asked about the process and progress of calling a new pastor. Perhaps now is a good time to review how this happens.

- 1. A call committee has been appointed made up of three persons from each congregation. They have completed a Ministry Site Profile which describes the two congregations and identifies our needs. The call committee has submitted this to the synod office.
- 2. The synod staff is now beginning a search for possible candidates who match the needs of the congregation and upon identifying these individuals, will give names and background information about these candidates to the call committee.
- 3. After receiving names of potential candidates, the call committee studies the background information of each candidate and selects one or more candidates to interview.
- 4. When the call committee identifies the person they believe is right for our two congregation parish, the call committee recommends the candidate to the church councils. The councils may choose to interview the candidate.

- 6. When a candidate is recommended by the councils, a congregational meeting is scheduled at each church and the congregations vote on the recommendation. If the congregations approve the recommendation, a call is extended to the pastor; if the congregations do not approve the recommendation, the process starts over.
- 7. When a call is extended, the pastor decides whether or not to accept the call.
- 8. After the pastor accepts the call, the pastor notifies his or her congregation. Usually 30 days notice is given. The pastor then begins her or his ministry with us.

How long will this take? There is no way of knowing. Meanwhile, we have work to do. The mission of Christ continues in the Olsburg and Walsburg communities!

So then, as we begin this new year, please be in prayer for our churches and let us move forward in the confidence that God will be with us and will empower us with the Holy Spirit so that we can faithfully witness to Christ's saving work.

As the word of the Lord says, "Therefore, my beloved, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." (1 Corinthians 15:58)

There are many families that need our help, so you are encouraged to attend and show your support while enjoying fellowship and hot soup.


#### Rejoicing with our Members
