From the Desk of Pastor Keith...

I want to extend a personal invitation to you to worship during Holy Week and Easter.

There are commercials on TV which say, "it doesn't get any better than this." Christians reserve such praise for Easter! Easter is the crown of the whole year, the queen of feasts, the highest Christian festival. Easter is the richest and most joyous season of the year. Truly, it doesn't get any better than this!

It doesn't get any better than hearing the Easter story of Jesus rising from the dead. It doesn't get any better than experiencing the Presence of the Risen Lord in bread and wine. It doesn't get any better than gathering with other Christians to share in the hope and the promise of Easter.

So don't miss out. The Festival of Easter, followed by the season of Easter (which lasts seven weeks), is time to awaken from sleep, to come alive, to begin anew. Don't let lesser concerns crowd out the joy and excitement of Easter. Don't let anything separate you from the God who delights in Easter surprises. Don't let anything keep you from singing Easter alleluias! Make Easter worship your top priority.

And certainly, Easter is all the more wonderful when you have followed Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, and then to the Upper Room on Maundy Thursday (which we will observe on Wednesday this year), and then to the cross on Good Friday. These holy week services make Easter all the spectacular!
