### From the Desk of Pastor Keith...

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you!

### There is a God!

A story is told of a rabbi in a European village, who one day summoned the townspeople to the village square. He said he had an important announcement. The people gathered, but with much grumbling at the inconvenience. The merchant resented having to close his business. The wife complained because she had so many errands to run. The teacher was upset because she had to leave her students. The blacksmith was angry because he had to shut down his fire. But, out of respect, they all went (unwillingly!) to the town square.

When all were present, the rabbi said, "I wish to announce there is a God in the world." That was all he said. But the people understood. They knew they had been acting as if God did not exist.

Easter Sunday is a time we announce there is a God in the world! In spite of the troubles of the world, the problems we face, the burdens we carry, the heartaches we suffer, the worries we bear, we gather (willingly and eagerly, I assume!) to announce to the world that there is a God. People around us may act as if there is no God. But we know better! On Easter we gaze into the empty tomb and know that God is alive!

### Holy Week and Easter <u>Palm Sunday - April 14</u>

Follow Jesus as he enters Jerusalem and prepares to die for you. What a Lord! What grace! This service prepares us for the week ahead, a week that is truly Holy!

### <u> Maundy Thursday - April 18</u>

On this night Jesus gave his followers the command to love one another and prepared a special meal called Holy Communion. We gather at 7:00 pm at Walsburg to remember the events of that night and to break bread with our Lord and with one another.

### Good Friday - April 19

On this Friday we call Good we gather at 7:00 pm at Olsburg to tell the story which is at the heart and center of our faith. Because of Good Friday, we are justified by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Do not hurry by the cross on your way to Easter joy, for we know the Risen Lord only through the Crucified Christ.

### Festival of Easter - April 21

The Easter season begins with the news that Jesus has risen from the dead! Come, share the joy and exhilaration of Easter! The Lord is risen! He is risen indeed! The Easter SonRise service begins at 6:45 am at Walsburg. The Festival Service of Worship at Olsburg begins at 9:00 am. The Festival Service of Worship at Walsburg begins at 11:00 am.

### Share the Good News!

Holy Week and Easter are great opportunities to invite family, friends and neighbors to come and hear the good news of Christ's death and resurrection. These services are powerful ways of revisiting the events which are at the center of our faith. Extend an invitation! Let them know that there is a place for them at worship throughout Holy Week and on Easter morning!

### Why We Give

Recently our two church councils learned that giving to each congregation in 2018 was significantly less than in previous years. In the light of Easter I thought it might be good for all of us to remember why we give.

It starts with Easter! It starts with the fantastic love of God who gives us life - the new life of Easter! It starts with all that Easter opens up for us - joy, love for the Lord, confident hope for the future, a bold and empowering Holy Spirit, eagerness to participate in Christ's work of giving life to the world.

Here are 7 reasons why we give (there are more!).

1. Because of Easter, I know that to love is to give.

2. Because of Easter, I love the Lord and giving is one way I can show my love.

3. Because of Easter, I trust the Lord will take care of me and give me what I need and enough to give to others.

4. Because of Easter, I know I have valuable gifts to give for the life of the world.

5. Because of Easter, I am eager to participate in Christ's mission of bringing Easter's life to the world and I want to do my part.

6. Because of Easter, I love the church and all it does to help me and others experience the joy and the new life of Easter and I want to give my best to my church.

7. Because of Easter, I am thankful for all that God has done for me and all that God has given to me, and I want my giving to express my love and my thankfulness.

Please pray with me. "Almighty God, you give us the joy of celebrating our Lord's resurrection. Give us also the joys of life in your service, and bring us at last to the full joy of life eternal, through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
