#### **Your Future Pastors**

It has been my privilege to represent you (and all the other people in the Central States Synod) on the Board of Directors of the Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago (LSTC), which is one of the eight seminaries of our church. I will be

attending a meeting of the Board on May 16-19 in Chicago and therefore will miss worship with you on Sunday, May 17. I am very grateful for the folks in each congregation who have agreed to lead worship that day.

Seminaries are vital to our church - they prepare our future pastors! I am concerned about seminaries, though, for three reasons.

First, we are facing a growing shortage of pastors in our church. Nearly 30% of the congregations in our synod are looking for a pastor. Even though enrollment at seminaries is increasing, it is not increasing fast enough to meet the demand.

Second, our seminaries are struggling to keep their doors open. Sixty years ago nearly 100% of the costs of seminary education were covered by the church. Today, about 20% of the costs comes from the wider church - the ELCA and the synods. The remaining 80% comes directly from students, alumni/ae, friends, congregations and other sources (like us!).

Third, the cost of a seminary education is making it harder for students to attend. When I graduated from the seminary in 1974, I was debt free. Today, many of the seminary graduates enter the ministry with significant debt. Will they be able to accept calls at churches which cannot afford to pay as much?

The seminaries are working hard to address these concerns. In the past few years I have seen great progress at LSTC! I am quite hopeful and confident that we will have good pastors in the years to come. We all need to work together,

though, to provide the support that is needed.

There is now new interest from genealogists in Sweden about the history and records of Swedish-founded churches in Kansas. A group based in Lyrestad, Sweden plan to visit Kansas this summer. They plan to visit our church and would like to meet some of our members and see some of the older records/documents and photographs. The Director of the Old Mill

Museum will let us know a schedule and possibly when they will be at our church. Please pass this information on to any that may have an interest in this project or have photos/information to share with the Swedish group.
