Reflections by Pastor Kaylie

Grace and peace to you all!

I hope you are taking care, enjoying the sun, and finding time to be at peace.

The Apostle Paul writes, "For you were called to freedom, brothers and sisters; only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for selfindulgence, but through love become slaves to one another." (Galatians 5:13) Through Christ, we have been set free to serve one another in love! The Greek term "doulos" is translated as "slaves." Doulos is the same term from which we derive our English word "doula." A doula is a trained companion that helps birth children into the world. They provide continuous physical and emotional support to a mother before and after birth. When Paul writes that we are slaves to one another, we can think of him saying we are one another's doula in love! Paul is calling us to be in service to one another. God calls us to act as doulas to help bring love into our world!

To be in service to one another means that we bear one another's burden and love one another as Christ has loved us. In Jesus, we witness God's love for this world. As Jesus travels around talking to strangers, feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, and providing care for his disciples, we see the

multitude of God's love. The same love that said the only law is "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." And we are called to follow in those footsteps- to love one another.

In these times, may you know the grace of God and feel God's love shine upon you. May you go out into your community (at home, in the store, at work, wherever you are) and seek to share God's love. As a community, may the Spirit live in us and guide us to be God's love doulas!
