We are now in the "dog days" of summer. "Dog days" is the name the ancient Romans gave to the hottest, most humid days of summer. The name came about because they associated the hottest days of summer with the star Sirius. Sirius was known as the "Dog Star" because it was the brightest star in the constellation Canis Major (Large Dog).

During the days of July and August, Sirius, the Dog Star, rises at the same time as the sun. Some people believed that the summer swelter was due to the combined heat from Sirius and the Sun. It is interesting that in the Greek language, Sirius means "scorching."

From ancient times the "dog days" of summer were marked by lethargy, inactivity, or indolence. Still today, we usually don't have much energy or desire to do anything when it is hot and humid outside.

So what should we be doing during these days? Some words from St. Paul's letter to the Galatians can help us. First, keep the faith! What counts is faith, says St. Paul. Keep looking to Jesus Christ. Keep listening to him. Keep on following him.

Second, just as plants keep on growing during these "dog days" of

summer, so should we. St. Paul says, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." These are days for growing the fruits of the Spirit.

The heat can sap our energy and cause us to grow weary. St. Paul says, "Let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest-time, if we do not give up. So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith."

We may be in the "dog days" of summer, but these are good days for living our faith and growing in our love for others and doing what is right.

Turning from the "dog days" of summer to our search for a new pastor, the call committee reports that our third candidate has taken a call to another congregation. So it is back to the search. Our call committee is doing good work! Now is the time for patience, as we wait for the Lord to give us a new pastor. Let's remember what the Lord says in Isaiah 60:22, "When the right time comes, I will make this happen quickly. I am the Lord!"
